In this process, she gained a deeper understanding of the sacred connections inherent in all of life. “I try to still the inner dialogue and the internal imagery so I can actually listen to the birds and notice and be present in my natural surroundings, she explains. “It’s been a very profound transformative shift in understanding, appreciating, and linking with all the other beings on the planet and the natural world. If

you follow a practice of spending time in nature sitting, listening and opening, then over time you begin to notice and see and hear and sense more. The world comes alive and starts speaking to you.”
