Biblical Witness

Joshua 6:10 - 16

To the people Joshua gave this command: "You shall not shout or let your voice be heard, nor shall you utter a word, until the day I tell you to shout. Then you shall shout." So the ark of the Lord went around the city of Jericho, circling it once; and they came into the camp, and spent the night in the camp. Then Joshua rose early the next morning, and once again the priests took up the ark of the Lord. The seven priests carrying the seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the Lord passed on, blowing the trumpets continually.
